

Important Safety Guidelines

The health and safety of our customers and employees has always been of the utmost importance to McEvoy Painting LLC. And now, more than ever, we want to assure you that safety measures will be strictly adhered to.

The following list of safety practices are designed to minimize risk and hopefully add to your peace of mind of having us working in your home. We are happy to discuss anything in greater detail and accommodate any additional requests you may have.

- **Virtual Quotes Available** We offer FaceTime or WhatsApp video chats to review your painting project and will provide an estimate via email.
- **Two-way Communication** You will be informed prior to the start of the job the crew who will work at your home. Please let us know in advance who will be at your home when we're there.
- **Zero Tolerance for Spreading Germs** All painters who are sick or who live in a household with anyone with flu-like symptoms will be required to stay home. We kindly ask our customers to inform us if anyone in their household becomes ill.
- **Sanitizing** As a courtesy, we ask all customers to clean and sanitize the work area prior to work beginning. If this is not feasible, we will make this the first order of business when we arrive. We will use disinfectant wipes to clean commonly touched surfaces on a daily basis and as part of our end of the day cleanup.
- **Safety Equipment** We will wear masks and gloves, and will remove our shoes when walking to the work area and use alternative entryways when possible.
- **Cleaning Facilities** If possible, we request a powder room or bathroom for our use that is not utilized by your family. We need a sink where we can frequently wash our hands, and will bring our own hand soap, hand sanitizer, and disinfectant wipes.
- **Social Distancing** We will remain at least 6 feet away from all household members and pets. We will accommodate if you need to enter a room where we are working. After all, this is your home and we want this painting project to be as convenient as possible for you. As always, we will stay in the work area and will ask permission before going anywhere else in your home. Where practical, the interior work area also can be partitioned off with a plastic zip wall.

These are simply general guidelines, obviously every household is unique and we are committed to be understanding and flexible with any special concerns. We believe there are practical ways of moving forward and improving your home in a safe manner that doesn't put anyone at risk.
