As we enter week 14 of quarantine, I am excited to share that the Good Neighbor Society has begun to lift some of the restrictions put in place due to COVID-19! With the guidelines set by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the state and local public health officials the following changes have been implemented.

Residents are now able to leave their room for meals and partake in communal dining.

Residents are wearing a mask on the way to and from meals and can remove their mask when they get to the dining room table. Social distancing is being maintained with only two residents per table, spaced six feet apart. The residents on each unit are dining together and to continue social distancing there are four dining rooms instead of two.

Group activities have resumed! The recreation department is completing separate activities for residents on each unit and social distancing is being maintained during group events. Residents are also required to wear a facemask during activities. Residents in isolation will remain in their room for meals and will only be allowed to participate in group activities once isolation restrictions are lifted. All other precautions that were implemented due to COVID-19 are still being followed at this time.

With the reopening of businesses in the community, please know that the virus is still circulating and is a potential threat! Please continue to practice social distancing and wear a face mask when you are out in the community! The Good Neighbor Society would like to continue to lift restrictions, but this will depend on the spread of the virus as our utmost importance is the safety and health of the residents. Again, thank you for your continued support as we navigate through these uncharted waters.




